GOLF COURSES

LE MAÎTRE • Designed by Fred Couples, this 7,069-yard course offers over 260 acres of scenic river-front that includes dramatic elevation changes, glorious vistas, and mature forests along with incomparable service. (Par 72)

LE MANITOU • A new executive 3,400-yard course of championship calibre built in a magnificent setting along the Devil's River (Rivière de La Diable), in a pine forest interspersed with marshes and sand dunes. (Par 58)

LE DIABLE • Host of the Skins games in 1999, this 7,056-yard course has a lot to offer. Magnificent Arizona-style course located alongside the picturesque Devil's River (Rivière Le Diable). For players who like to challenge themselves! (Par 71)

LE GÉANT • Two artificial lakes, 52 pristine white sand traps and cleverly designed plateaus on 6,836 yards combine to make Le Géant an exciting course! (Par 72)

LA BÊTE GRAY ROCKS • Panoramic views make this championship course memorable, its 6,825 yards surrounded by the Devil's River (Rivière de La Diable) and pine-covered plateaus. (Par 72)

LA BELLE GRAY ROCKS • A renowned 6,270-yard course that has been enjoyed for more than 79 years. A classic mountain course that appeals to every level of player. (Par 72)

ROYAL LAURENTIEN • This spectacular championship golf course located 20 minutes south of Tremblant is rated one of the top 10 courses in Québec. (Par 71)

ACADÉMIE DE GOLF • The specialized facilities and true-to-game course conditions of the Academy provide a wide range of learning and play areas with certified professionals to improve any level of play. (Various programs available.)
