**1. AIRPORT WITH A DIFFERENCE.** Ever been greeted at the gates by a cute French-speaking guy and a glass of honey wine? At the Mont Tremblant International Airport, that's what happens. No surly customs agents or crowded baggage carousels. Sit by the fire while your luggage is loaded.

**3. HOTEL QUINTESSENCE.** This lakeside hotel puts some others to shame. Everything is so well thought out, with the most minute detail attended to, that it's almost surreal. The rooms are mammoth, with real wood-burning fireplaces (gas ones are for wimps) attended to by a fireplace concierge, deep bathtubs with jets, and plush, tasteful furnishings. It's a true slice of heaven in the Laurentians.

**4. GOOD EATS.** Restaurants like La Grappe à Vin and La Forge Bar & Grill deliver world-class cuisine and service at tiny-town prices. Stoke up your body pre-ski with breakfast at Le Shack or a sugar fix from Chocolaterie Rocky Mountain.

**5. SPA FUN.** At Spa Le Scandinave, guests go to extremes, running from hot tub to frigid pools and an even colder natural river. Why? The locals believe it's good for you. Perhaps more relaxing is getting a massage in a warm room inside and listening to the screams as others dash around outside in sub-zero temperatures. Option two: have an in-room massage next to your fireplace at Quintessence.

**6. NOT SKIING.** If skiing just isn't your thing, don't fret. There are plenty of other outdoor activities to amuse you. Try ice climbing, snow tubing, snowshoeing or chasing snowflakes.

**7. APRES-SKI SCENE.** The crowd at Tremblant knows how to keep warm by partying. Wedge yourself into the midst of the crowd at one of the resort's nightspots. Le P'tit Caribou and La Forge Bar & Grill (downstairs) attract the young and supple set. Beer lovers are in good hands at Microbrasserie La Diable where a 60-oz. pitcher is just \$18.

**8. CLOSE TO YOU.** A flight from Toronto to the number one ski resort in Eastern Canada is just over an hour long.
